

Open Post-Doc Positions in Finance at Frankfurt School, faculty mentor Sascha Steffen

The Finance Department at Frankfurt School of Finance & Management invites applications for two-year post-doctoral fellowships in finance beginning fall semester 2022 (or earlier). The successful applicant will contribute to the department through research and work closely with faculty mentor Sascha Steffen. The position does not involve teaching but contribution to policy relevant research at the research institute "Financial Intermediaries and the Real Economy" (FIRE). Applications from scholars with demonstrated research interests in financial intermediation and private debt markets, climate finance and FinTechs are particularly encouraged to apply.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should expect to complete a PhD in finance by September 1, 2022. Since this is an early career position, applicants that received their PhD within the last three years benefit the most from this opportunity. Strong quantitative background and working knowledge using statistical packages (Stata, R, Python) and in artificial intelligence and machine learning required.

Please include a minimum of two research papers and three recommendation letters in the application package.

We will consider all candidates who apply before the positions are filled. To ensure consideration for the first round of interviews, candidates should apply by November 15, 2021. The first round of interviews will be held virtually in December. Applications after this deadline will be evaluated on a rolling basis, so early application is encouraged.
